



Advance Care Training can offer a number of smaller qualifications linked to the Qualification credit framework (QCF). If the candidate wishes to continue their studies the credits gained can be used towards a full diploma.

**Certificate**: 13-36 credits available in the following subjects at levels 2/3:

- Dementia Care

This qualification consists of 5 units resulting in 14 credits. For this qualification the individual needs to be working with people who have dementia, as there is a requirement to show some competency in practice as well as classroom based learning and an expectation the learner will undertake some private study.

- Supporting individuals with learning disabilities

This qualification consists of a minimum of 6 units resulting in 21-23 credits. For this qualification the individual needs to be working with people with a learning disability as there is a requirement to show some competency in practice, as well as classroom based learning and an expectation the learner will undertake some private study.

- Preparing to work in adult social care

This qualification consists of 9 units resulting in 20 credits and is beneficial to individuals looking to work in the health and social care sector. It will be classroom based learning delivered over a number of days with an expectation the learner will undertake some private study.
