



Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health & Social Care.

What is the programme about?

National Vocational Qualifications are work related qualifications based on your ability to do your job in a given occupational area. To achieve the qualification a candidate has to demonstrate their skills in practice and their knowledge and understanding in what they are doing in order to become competent. The candidate will be assessed by a qualified NVQ assessor against a set of national standards, accredited by an Awarding Body. As part of the Government's modernisation programme, a set of National Occupational Standards were established for managers of care services. This level 5 qualification, is suitable for managers, deputies and others who hold managerial responsibilities and work in a variety of care settings. You will choose a specific pathway which will reflect your service: Children & Young people's pathway or Adult Pathway (residential, management, or advanced route)

What are the entry requirements?

No formal qualifications are necessary, but candidates must be working in care services, in a management capacity. It is essential that a learner has some experience in this sector.

How is it taught and assessed?

All learners will attend an induction day; with 3-4 workshop days to provide the theory, depending on the learner's needs. The learner will produce an e-Portfolio of evidence which will include observations in practice; written questions; work products and professional discussion. This e-Portfolio will be audited by the Internal verifier for quality purposes.

Guided learning hours are 700-800 per qualification and it is expected the Level 5 Diploma in Leadership to take approximately 18 months.

How many units do I complete?

All QCF Qualifications are made up of units, each with a credit value. Learners need to complete units, which total 80 credits. This will be made up from mandatory, pathway specific and option units, with a minimum of 16 units to complete.

Your option units will be chosen from the specific pathway chosen, depending on where you work.

Examples of option units include:

- Recruitment & Selection;
- Facilitate change;
- Understand how to manage a team;
- Explore models of disability
- Manage finance

Progression

This qualification will give the learner skills and knowledge competencies to perform at level 5. This can be built upon to aid further learning and career progression to a Higher Education qualification.

This Diploma is the recommended qualification by CQC for registered managers.

Cost: £1500.00 + VAT. This will include registration and certification with an Awarding Organisation; assessment and verification; e-portfolio license fee and formal training days.
